### Responsibilities

The Certified Peer Support Professional MCERT job duties include, but are not limited to:

- Follow-up with MCERT clients who have documented individual support logs
- Ensure that clients are satisfied with the services they have received and if not, help them advocate for what they need.
- Educate individuals and primary caretakers on how to advocate if services are not meeting their needs.
- Advise Clinical Supervisor as needed.
- Provide information and peer to peer support to individuals who are served by the program.
- Educate and empower clients and their supports regarding their roles in developing crisis plans and in crisis prevention.
- Educate service providers regarding an individual's role in developing a crisis plan for themselves and in crisis prevention. Ensure that the individual is an integral part of the crisis planning process.
- Maintain and model a consistent focus on strengths.
- Serve as a liaison to other local supports in the community.
- Link Individuals to Peer Support Services Activities such as Support Groups, Social Events, and Community Resources
